## Finished!

"It is finished," Jesus cried, and He breathed out His life. He died a triumphant death. The sin problem was solved. The price of sin was paid. Forgiveness could be offered. Physical life is a relationship of the soul and spirit to the body. When the soul and spirit leave the body the person is lifeless, dead. Eternal life is a relationship to God through faith in the crucified and risen Son of God, Jesus Christ the Lord.

Who can say, I have made my heart clean, I am pure from my sin? (Proverbs 20:9). What must I do to be saved? . . . Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved (Acts 16:30-31).

Have you put all of your trust in Jesus Christ and Him alone for your soul's salvation? Neither is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved (Acts 4:12).
