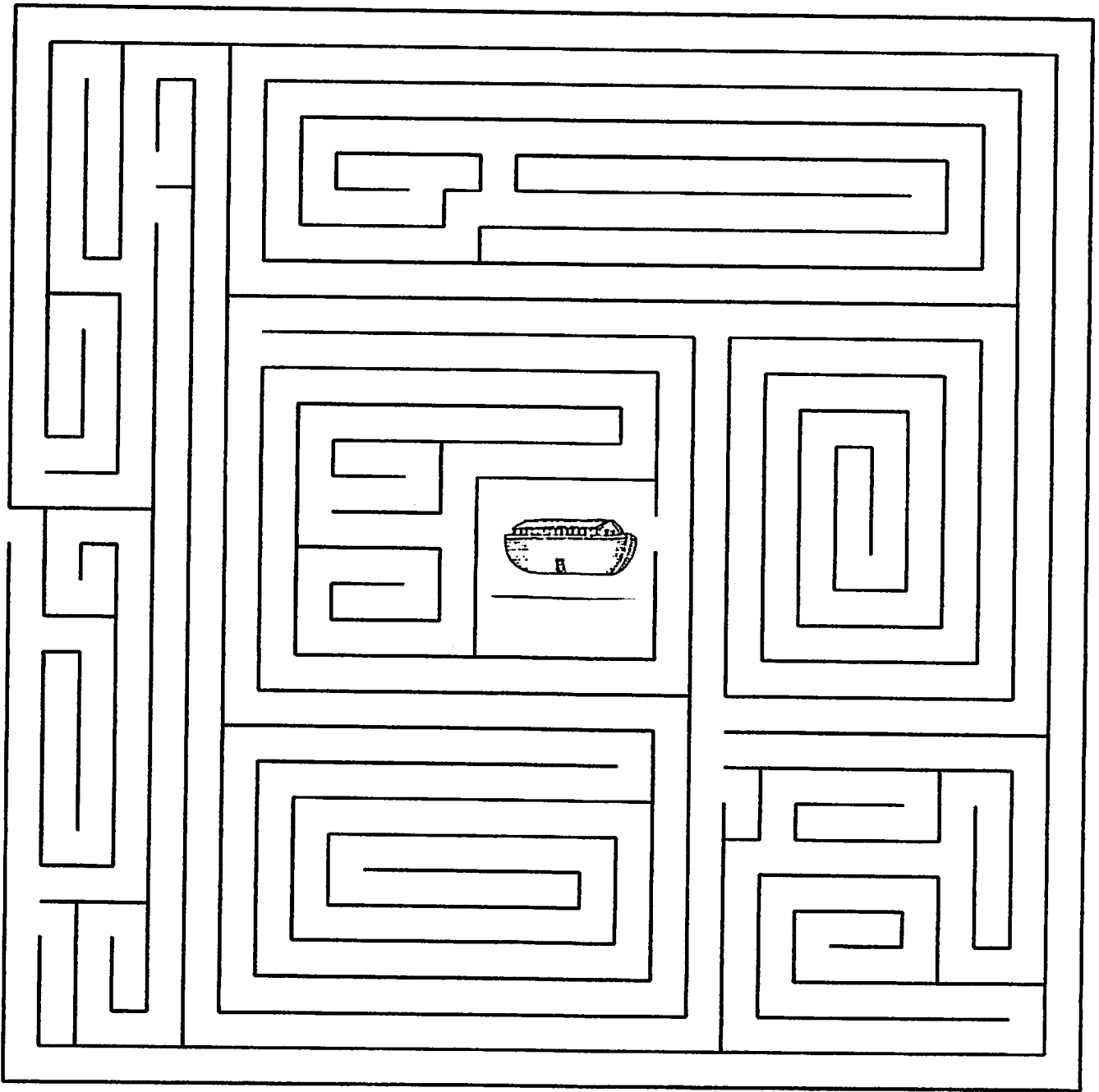
Romans 6:23

He's mad! He's crazy! Rain? A flood? We never heard of such things. Until that time it had not ever rained on the earth. God watered the ground at night with a mist. God told Noah that because of the sinfulness of world He would destroy the earth with a flood. People didn't believe Noah. People didn't believe God. They went about their sinful ways thinking and doing evil. They went about their daily lives, eating and drinking, living with no thought about God, their Creator. God gave them 120 years to turn around from their sinful ways. Noah preached while he prepared the ark according to God's instructions.
